Dear Parents and Guardians,

Windham Central Supervisory Union students are offered free and reduced priced meals base on their family income and other qualifying programs. This letter is a reminder that if your income has changed since the beginning of the school year or if you are now receiving benefits such as VT 3 Squares, Reach Up, Head Start or are homeless you can apply for meal benefits for your students. You are also eligible if you have recently become unemployed due to the federal government shut down. You can obtain a Free and Reduced Meal Application on the Windham Central S.U. website.

<https://www.windhamcentral.org/parents>. There you can print out the application and submit it to the administrative assistant at your children(s) school for processing. The administrative assistant will also be able to provide you with the application and advice on filling it out.

If you qualify the benefit will remain in effect for your students through the end of the 2018-19 school year.

All children need healthy meals to learn. If you feel your family may now qualify, we strongly encourage you to submit an application.
