If you would like financial assistance for L'AFTER Fees, please follow these steps to use our sliding scale

- 1) Use the Income Guidelines chart (located on the back of this page) to see if you are eligible for Free or Reduced Lunch. If so, please submit the Free/Reduced Application to your school office to be sure you access all of the benefits for your family. It will also help the school access funding.
- 2) If your income is above the limit for Free/Reduced eligibility, you may still request financial assistance to pay at the 75% level.
- 3) Use the chart below to calculate your registration fee for the total number of programs. There is a maximum fee of \$150 per family.
