Dear Families,

We will be offering school choice within WRMED (Jamaica Village School, NewBrook Elementary and Townshend Elementary) beginning in the fall of 2019, for kindergarten through fifth grade elementary students. Like many school districts in Vermont, our district is in a period of great growth and change. Choosing the school that will provide your child's elementary experience is an important decision and I appreciate the thought and care all of you will put into making this choice for your family. Thankfully, we have three excellent schools in our district that, while unified in many ways, each offer its own culture and experience for students.

There are key decisions that will influence your school choice decision. Some will be specific to your family circumstances and others will be specific to the school. I encourage you to set up a time to visit each of our schools, tour the building, and ask questions. When requests for school choice are honored this JANUARY, it may result in the need for staff changes to accommodate the change in enrollment in our schools. I encourage you to gather as much information about the school and community as you make your decision. The school will be the home to your child(ren) until 5th grade and everyone wants you to find the best possible match for your family.
