

CRAFT DAY – Monday, December 10th

Parents are encouraged to help their child fill out the first two columns of the form listing loved ones for whom the child wishes to make a gift. It is helpful to know the relationship (i.e. grandparent, aunt, etc). For safety/choking concerns and appropriateness, ages of any children for whom they are making gifts is also useful; a teen-aged cousin would not receive the same gift as a baby brother. There will be many various crafts to choose from and each child will have an opportunity to make approximately ten gifts. The children are also encouraged to make one extra to be donated to West River Valley Senior Housing in Townshend, VT.

This form should be returned to your child’s teacher by Friday, December 7, 2018. Please send in a large brown paper (bag w/ handles works best) or large reusable grocery bag to which it will be stapled. (The bag will go home with the child--full of gifts).

For those of you who have not been involved before, it is an incredible experience that encourages children to think about others and what might make someone else happy, rather than just wanting things for themselves.
